Overview

National Vocational Qualifications (NVQs) are nationally recognised qualifications gained in the workplace. They are based on National Occupational Standards, which are standards written by employers and experts in your industry.

When your employee (candidate) achieves the NVQ it will prove that they can work to the standards expected by employers in your industry including those responsible for managing properties. An employee with a NVQ will show others you are employing competent persons to do a job and have the skills, knowledge and understanding needed to do it well.

Who will be involved in your NVQ?

- The assessor is the person you will have the most contact with as you work towards your NVQ.
- Your assessor will
- help you identify any training you need
- agree an assessment plan with you
- help you plan and organise your workload and evidence
- observe you carrying out your job in the workplace over a period of time
- ask you questions about the work you do
- make decisions about your evidence
- judge when you are competent and meet the national standards
- give you feedback about your evidence and competence.

Candidate role and responsibilities

- Your responsibilities as a City & Guilds NVQ candidate are to provide your NVQ centre with your personal details so you can be registered with City & Guilds
- participate in an initial assessment and induction
- agree a personal assessment plan with your assessor
- collect and organise your evidence as agreed in your assessment plan
- attend regular meetings with your assessor to discuss your progress and to amend your plan when required

- meet with other centre and City & Guilds staff to talk about your NVQ and evidence

- make sure you understand and comply with Health and Safety law and regulations.
